



Islands of New England

October 2 - 8, 2009

This seven day tour starts in Providence, Rhode Island. From there we travel to Newport, the “Yachting Capital of the East” and the home of 11 historic mansions of America’s Gilded Age. Then we travel to historic Boston where we can walk the famed Freedom Trail. Next we travel to Plymouth, the site of the Pilgrims landing. Following a ferry ride to Martha’s Vineyard, a local guide will show us the highlights of the island. The next day we will ferry to Nantucket Island where we will experience the charm of its shingled cottages and lighthouses. Back on the mainland, we will visit Hyannis and travel to Provincetown, the northernmost tip of Cape Cod.

Our tour will include:

- Round trip airfare from Los Angeles to Providence.
- Double room accommodations for three nights at the Hilton Providence & four nights at the Radisson, Hyannis.
- 11 meals - 7 breakfasts and 4 dinners.
- Tour of Providence, Rhode Island including State Capitol, the Baptist Meeting House & Brown University.
- Tour of Marble House in Newport, the gorgeous summer cottage of Mr. and Mrs. William Vanderbilt.
- Comprehensive tour of Boston - Beacon Hill, State Capitol, Old South Meeting House, Public Gardens, the Old North Church, the U.S.S. Constitution and Faneuil Hall Marketplace.
- Tour of a traditional New England cranberry bog.
- Visit Plymouth Rock and board a reproduction of the Mayflower, the ship used by the Pilgrims on their journey from Europe.
- Tour of Plimoth Plantation, a re-creation of a 17th century Pilgrim village.
- Tour of Martha’s Vineyard including quaint gingerbread-style cottages, a once famous whaling port with sea captain’s homes. Afterwards, enjoy a traditional New England Lobster feast.
- Tour of Nantucket Island and leisure time to explore or stroll along the waterfront.
- Tour of Hyannis and visit to the Kennedy Memorial. Continue on to Provincetown, a lively artist colony.
- Farewell dinner onboard an elegant dinner train.
